Smarter Giving, Greater Impact McDonaghs Donate \$256,838 in Shares

In November 2025, Rod and Joanne McDonagh made a generous personal gift of \$256,383 to the Wintham & District Hospital Foundation through the direct donation of publicly traded securities.

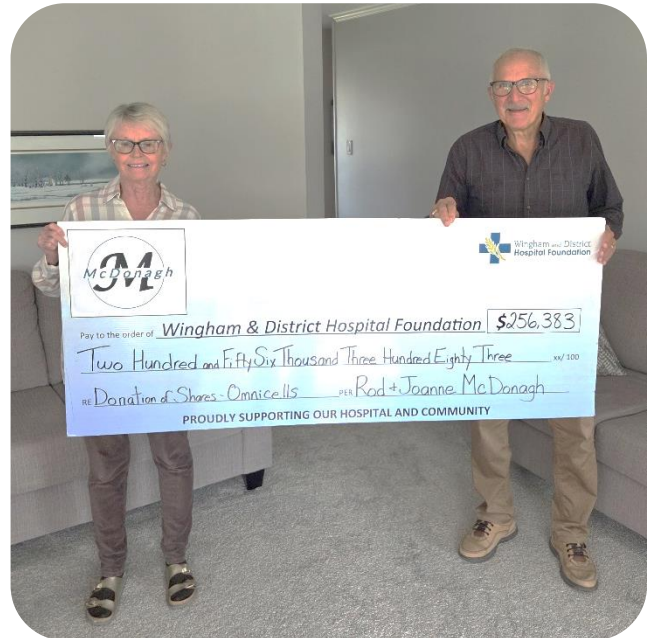
After learning about this tax-efficient giving option from their financial advisor, the McDonaghs chose to donate stock market shares instead of cash. When securities are donated directly, donors avoid paying capital gains tax on the increase in value and receive a charitable tax receipt for the full market value. This receipt can be used to reduce taxes owing, can be claimed by either spouse to maximize savings, and can be carried forward for up to five years, if needed.

For many donors, this approach means they can give more to charity at a lower overall after-tax cost.

The McDonaghs' gift will support the urgent replacement of an Omnicell unit. Omnicells are high-tech medication dispensing cabinets that help reduce medication errors and ensure the safe storage of controlled substances.

"Rod and Joanne have been longtime supporters of our hospital," said WDH Foundation Executive Director Nicole Duquette. "We're grateful for their continued generosity and for choosing such an impactful way to give."

Future Care Collective Club Raises \$34,200 for Ultrasound

The Future Care Collective hosted its second event - and first Showdown Reception – in March 2026. *Pitches & Pitchers* brought members together for a ballpark-inspired evening featuring a themed menu and friendly competition. The highlight was the pitch contest, where medical professionals presented equipment needs at the hospital.

Three projects were pitched: Dr. Sean Henderson spoke about new defibrillators for the ER. Jaide Campbell, Diagnostic Imaging Manager, alongside Medical Radiation Technologist Heather Logan, presented a new ultrasound machine. Orthopedic tools were pitched by Manager of Surgical Services Tori Ducharme and Director of Operations Michelle Wick.

Future Care Collective members then cast their votes to determine which project would receive the \$34,200 raised through the annual contributions of the club’s 52 members. The winning project was the new ultrasound machine, which will help improve imaging quality and support access to fast and accurate diagnoses.



“The Showdown Reception is a unique opportunity for our members to directly connect with the hospital team,” said Executive Director Nicole Duquette-Jutzi. “Having their voices heard makes their support truly meaningful”.

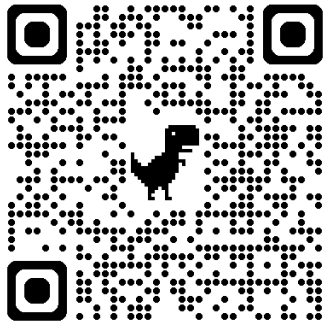


Joey Havers Memorial Walk by Mary Havers
